

## ***Allen, Gossage Highlight CBM Autograph Event***

Chicago baseball fans will get a rare chance to connect with White Sox greats on Sunday, June 24, when Dick Allen and Rich (Goose) Gossage are scheduled to sign a limited number of autographs as part of the Chicago Baseball Museum tribute to the 1972 team this month.

Allen and Gossage will be joined by 1972 team members Hank Allen, Roland Hemond, Bart Johnson and Jay Johnstone at the event, which will begin at 6 p.m. at 94 West Steak and Seafood, 15410 S. 94th Ave., Orland Park.

Ron Allen also will be in attendance. Dick, Hank and Ron Allen form the oldest living brother combination to have played in the major leagues.

Don Lenza's THEDON Sports will coordinate the autograph event.

A maximum of 75 tickets per guest will be sold on a first-come, first served basis. Persons who purchase a \$25 gift certificate to 94 West restaurant will receive priority placement in line.

A Super Ticket will include one autograph for every guest and a maximum total of two inscriptions at no charge. The price is \$100 for baseballs and flat items and \$150 for all other material.

Autographs of Allen and Gossage will be \$40 each for flats and baseballs and \$60 for other items. Inscriptions are \$10 each.

For the other guests, the price is \$15 per autograph with one complimentary inscription.

Memorabilia will be available to be purchased and signed.

Payment can be made in advance via PayPal at [Info@Chicagobaseballmuseum.org](mailto:Info@Chicagobaseballmuseum.org). Please state the guest and type of item to be signed. Cash, personal check and credit cards will be accepted at the event.

Because of limited time, there will be no photograph opportunities.

Tickets to the Chicago Baseball Museum tribute to Allen and the 1972 White Sox team also will be available at the event. The fundraiser will begin at 6 p.m. in the Stadium Club at U.S. Cellular Field on Monday, June 25. Tickets are \$100 for the dinner and \$150 for the dinner and pre-event cocktail party.

In addition to Gossage, Hemond and Dick and Hank Allen, 1972 team members Tom Bradley, Carlos May, Bill Melton and Ed Spiezio are expected to be in attendance. White Sox Interactive senior correspondent Mark Liptak and Sun-Times columnist-WLS Radio host Richard Roeper will serve as emcees.
